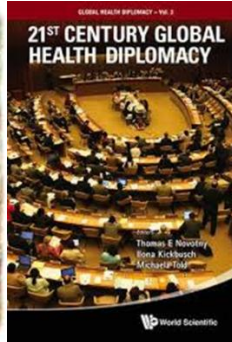

Course: Global Health Diplomacy

Course Description: Global Health Diplomacy (GHD) is an interdisciplinary field that combines skills and techniques from epidemiology, international relations, foreign policy analysis and diplomacy. GHD aims to accomplish health and complimentary non-health goals via development programs that are both “smart” and synergistically dynamic. The specific objectives of the GHD module include an introduction to current theories and best practices, the development of participant capacity, and a detailed understanding and overview of contemporary issues in the field.

Participant Profile: This course is designed for students and professionals engaging in the fields of international relations, conflict resolution, foreign policy, diplomacy, medicine, and global health. The course is also designed to build global health diplomacy capacity in organizations such as Irish Aid, and will be of particular interest to non-governmental organizations working in developing countries. The module will also significantly benefit students who may be considering working or volunteering with international organizations.

Course Assessment & Coordination: There is no course assessment component; however, attendees will be entitled to 5 credits for either Continuous Professional Development purposes or the European Credit Transfer System. The course will be facilitated by Sebastian Kevany (BA, MA, MPH) and Marcus Matthews (Dip, BA, MA); who combine extensive experience in GHD and international relations.
